Award**

The award recipient will receive **\$1,000** and a Certificate of Honor.

Eligibility

Certified kindergarten through five teachers currently teaching in the Easton/Redding, Masuk, Newtown, Shelton, and Trumbull Public School System and have developed a successful curriculum project implemented in the classroom as part of the curriculum during the current or previous academic year are eligible to apply.

- Joint applications will not be accepted.
- Projects previously submitted for this award are not eligible for resubmission.
- Projects which have previously won this award are not eligible.
- Relatives of past or present Trustees of The Weller Foundation, Incorporated are not eligible.

• This award will not be offered unless at least two qualified applicants apply.
