# Senior Science, Eleanor F. Moore Business and Paul W. Broggi Communications Awards

## Overview

The Weller Foundation, Incorporated\* is a non-profit organization established in 1962 to provide financial assistance to educational, charitable, and civic organizations. Each year, the Foundation presents several School Award Programs. The purpose of each program is simple: to honor young people who have demonstrated the ability to achieve.

### Senior Science Awards (since 1962)

This Award is granted to a Senior student from each of the five local high schools (Joel Barlow, Masuk, Newtown, Shelton, and Trumbull) who have demonstrated the ability to achieve recognition in science. The Award is given to students who intend to pursue a career in science.

### Eleanor F. Moore Business Awards (since 1973)

This Award is granted to a Senior\*\* student from each of the five local high schools who have demonstrated the ability to achieve recognition in business. The Award is given to students who intend to pursue a career in business. The Award was named after the late Eleanor F. Moore, the first Personnel Director at Vitramon, Incorporated.

### Paul W. Broggi Communications Awards (since 1986)

This Award is granted to a Senior student from each of the five local high schools who have demonstrated the ability to achieve recognition in communications. The Award is given to students who intend to pursue a career in communications. The Award was named after the late Paul W. Broggi, a Director of Advertising and Public Relations at Vitramon, Incorporated.

Recipients of the Senior Science, Eleanor F Moore and Paul W Broggi Awards will receive a cash award of \$500.
