The Weller Excellence in Teaching Award* is presented annually to recognize the teaching quality and innovation exhibited by certified classroom teachers in grades kindergarten through five. This honor hopes to encourage the teaching excellence vital to our youth.

Award**

The award recipient will receive \$1,000 and a Certificate of Honor.

Eligibility

Certified kindergarten through five teachers currently teaching in the Easton/Redding, Monroe, Newtown, Shelton, and Trumbull Public School System and have developed a successful curriculum project implemented in the classroom as part of the curriculum during the current or previous academic year are eligible to apply.

- Joint applications will not be accepted.
- Projects previously submitted for this award are not eligible for resubmission.
- Projects which have previously won this award are not eligible.
- Relatives of past or present Trustees of The Weller Foundation, Incorporated are not eligible.

The Trustees reserve the right to exercise their discretion on all matters.

Notes

 This award will not be offered unless at least two qualified applicants apply. The 2024 recipient is not eligible to apply for the 2025 award but can apply in 2026 or subsequent years.
